

Pedestrian Counts




A pedestrian is a person walking or running or travelling by means of a wheelchair, electric scooter, crutches or other walking devices or mobility aids.

You are going to count the number of people that pass you for a period of **5 minutes**.

You need to imagine a line across the street. You should divide yourself into teams. One team will count the pedestrians travelling towards the town/city centre. The other team will count the number of pedestrians travelling away from the town/city centre.

Use a tally system while conducting the survey:



You should record your data in a table similar to the one below:
